

TOURNAMENT RECAP





Not knowing what the level of interest would be in the event, a goal was set to raise \$1,000 for charity. That first year, the support and interest was overwhelming, and the total amount donated to charity was \$8,602.58.

Fast-forwarding to this year, the sixth annual ESC event, the interest and support has grown significantly. The 2017 event was the first time that we raised less money than the previous year. I can proudly say that trend did not continue this year. The 2018 ESC event raised \$27,431.78. That total sets a new yearly high!
