That is until the skies opened up late Friday afternoon as a monsoon rained down covering the fields with several inches of water merely 12 hours before the first pitch.

The beer got cold, the fields drained, and in the end, the eleventh ESC tournament, featuring more teams than ever before, went off without a hitch. I always love the competition on the field, but the ESC tournament brings so much more than that. It is the comradery between coworkers competing towards a common goal. Performance reached the finals for a Construction Division record fourth straight year, facing a team from ExxonMobil. Although ExxonMobil started off with a 3 run first inning, Performance answered with 6 of their own, and never trailed again. Each time ExxonMobil chipped away at the lead, Performance answered. The game stayed close through 5 innings with Performance leading 22 - 18.

In the top of the 6th inning, Performance held ExxonMobil scoreless before scoring 6 more runs to win the game and secure their 3-Peat.





Once again, the Sigma Blue team dominated its way through pool and bracket play to reach the finals. GIS Blue, making their first finals appearance, jumped up to an early 3 - 0 lead after the first inning. Sigma responded by scoring 13 runs over the next 4 innings, including a 7 run 3rd inning, taking an 12 - 3 lead after 5. Facing a run-rule, GIS rallied to score 9 runs in the 6th to tie the game at 12. With the momentum on GIS's side; however, the unwavered Sigma squad responded with 8 runs in the bottom of the 6th to take the 20 - 12 lead, and ultimately win by that score.




